

FEI Driving Rules, effective 1st January 2014 CAI1* Combined Marathon Notes for Guidance

Updated September 2014

The Notes for Guidance for CAI1* Combined Marathon have to also be read in conjunction with the FEI World Cup Driving Rules when applicable.

Competition: A Combined Marathon will be run as a Fault competition. A Fault competition is conducted on the basis of penalties for obstacles knocked down and 0.2 penalties* per second for time on course.

(*effective 1st January 2015 will be 0.25 penalties per second for time on course as per FEI Driving Rules.)
