Winter Series July to October 2017



SERIES INFORMATION

The RIVERINA STOCKFEEDS Winter Series includes a Dressage & Cones Series and a Combined Marathon Series. The Series will consist of three events: 2 July, 20 August & 1 October 2017. Details of the Series are outlined below.

1* Dressage & Cones Series

- Drivers will drive one dressage test followed by one cones course at each event.
- 'Presentation' attire is required during the dressage including gloves, apron and hat. Presentation will be judged on the move.
- Dressage test is able to be called to the driver by groom (groom can carry a copy of the test) or other caller only in Preliminary classes without penalty. The caller is not permitted to 'coach' the driver during the test.
- All drivers must carry a whip during the dressage test.
- The following vehicle types are acceptable:
 - o 2 wheel and 4 wheel vehicles.
 - o Vehicles with pneumatic tyres and jogger type vehicles.
 - o Vehicles that are not 138cm track width (narrower and wider track widths accepted).
- Dressage and cones scores will be combined to determine the final placing.
- Preliminary, Intermediate and Advanced classes offered.
- Drivers can enter more than one horse/pony (separate entry required).
- Horses/ponies can be driven by more than one driver (separate entry required).
- There are prizes for each class at each event.

1* Combined Marathon Series

- Drivers will drive the combined marathon course once at each event.
- The Combined Marathon course of approx. 800m consists of approx. 12 cone-type obstacles and two marathon-type obstacles and is driven at free (any) pace.
- Map of the Combined Marathon course will be provided and the course will be able to be walked from 7am on the day of the competition.
- This competition will be run as a Time competition, on the basis of the time in seconds taken to complete the course plus any penalties for faults converted to penalty seconds. (basically, the fastest time with the least penalties wins).
- Knocking down one or both balls of a single cones obstacle (pair of cones) will incur 3 penalty seconds in each case.
- Marathon obstacle rules and penalties apply for the marathon obstacles in the Combined Marathon.
- Drivers are not required to carry whip in hand during the Combined Marathon.
- Driver and groom (if applicable) must be wearing helmets during the Combined Marathon.
- Casual/Marathon attire acceptable. Apron and gloves not required.
- Grooms are able to talk to driver during the Combined Marathon in all classes.
- The following vehicle types are acceptable:
 - o 2 wheel and 4 wheel vehicles.
 - o Vehicles with pneumatic tyres and jogger type vehicles.
 - o Vehicles that are not 125cm track width.
- Preliminary, Intermediate and Advanced classes offered.
- Drivers can enter more than one horse/pony (separate entry required).
- Horses/ponies can be driven by more than one driver (separate entry required).
- There are prizes for each class at each event.



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General Information

- To be considered for overall series winner you must enter the same combination of horse and driver in the same class for all three events in the series.
- Overall series scores will be determined by combining your scores for three events.
- The Dressage & Cones series is completely separate to the Combined Marathon series and each series will be awarded a separate overall winner. You are able to enter one series and not the other and still be considered for overall winner in the series you competed in.
- You are able to enter as few as one event and you will be able to win a prize at that event but you will not be considered for an overall place in series.

Note: There are no restrictions on which level of competition (preliminary, intermediate or advanced) that competitors can enter, however it is recommended that competitors choose a level that is appropriate for the level of training and experience of their equine/s.

EVENT AND VENUE DETAILS

- **Dressage** – Dressage arena will be 100m x 40m. A separate 100m x 40m warm up arena will also be available.

All Preliminary Classes: *EA Novice 1*

All Intermediate Classes: *FEI 1*B (former Test 1)*

All Advanced Classes: *FEI 2*A*

- **Cones** – This will be conducted as a fault competition and all of the cones will be measured. Preliminary classes – 40cm allowance, Intermediate classes – 30cm allowance, Advanced classes – 22cm allowance. (Note: Horse team Preliminary – 50cm allowance, Intermediate – 40cm allowance, Advanced – 32 cm allowance).



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- **Combined Marathon** – This will be conducted as a time competition and all of the cones will be measured. The combined marathon course will be available for inspection and to be walked from 7am on the day of the competition. The marathon obstacles are all purpose built

- **Catering** - Lunch (BBQ sausage sizzle) and drinks will be available on site for a small fee.
- **Camping and Facilities** – There is plenty of camping space at Strongfield Stud and there are septic toilets and showers with warm water in the camping grounds. Camping is free.
- **Yards**–Competitors are welcome to bring their own yards. There are a number of day yards available for use. Competitors use yards at their own risk. Numbers are limited, so please indicate if you require the use of a yard on the entry form. There will be no extra fee for the use of yards.
- **Water** –Clean bore water is available for use and there are taps located near the yards and stables. Bring your own water containers for your horses. There is a concrete wash bay with a hose for washing horses. Fresh tank water is also available for human drinking water only.
- **Dogs** – Dogs are not permitted.
- **Loading Ramp** – An earth loading ramp is located near the camping ground to load/unload carriages and horses if needed.

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CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



This event will be conducted under the F.E.I. Rules for Driving Events as at 1st January 2015 with variations and additional regulations included in this schedule.

Drivers must be Warwick Club members or EA members. A restricted membership form for this event must be completed for drivers who are not Warwick Club members or EA members. Club Receipts or current Membership Cards (Club or EA) must be available for checking if required to receive Competitors Kits. Horses are not required to be registered with EA.

All competitors and their navigators/grooms compete at their own risk. The organising committee and land holders accept no responsibility for loss or damage to horses, owners, passengers, equipment, drivers, grooms or spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever, whilst at or near the venue, during the course of this event. All competitors, by entering this event, agree to be bound by this regulation.

All child/junior drivers between 12 and 18 years must be accompanied by a capable groom 18 years or over in all phases of the competition. Whenever a child/junior is in a vehicle they must be wearing an equestrian type helmet that complies with one of the three standards below.

Carriage weight restrictions are not enforced at this event. Conflict of interest rules (article 984 point 3) are not enforced at this event.

Appeals, together with \$20, are to be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money may be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.

The organisers reserve the right to:

- * Alter any advertised times;
- * Refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason;
- * Refuse admission to any person whose attendance may, in the opinion of the Organising Committee, impose a risk on the person, or to Warwick Club and EA members, or members of the public; or due to inappropriate behavior or failure to comply with the Club's and EA expected standard of behavior;
- * Measure any horse or pony upon discretion
- * Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class

Entry fees must accompany nominations.

The event will be run on time. Any competitor late for a scheduled starting time will be awarded time penalties. In the event of an accident, or any other occurrence beyond the control of the competitor, contact the Secretary to arrange an alternate starting time.

Organisers reserve the right to penalize competitors for unsafe practices.

Back protectors are recommended for the marathon.

The wearing of equestrian helmets complying with one of the three standards listed below and on the entry form is mandatory in the marathon and medical arm bands are recommended.

Equestrian helmets standards

1. AS/NZS 3838,
2. European Standard EN1384,
3. United States Standard ASTN F1163

It is a condition of entry that competitors hand to the organisers a Horse Health Declaration Form before you receive your competitors kit.
